


Registration

Once you are on the Harmony SEL website, click "Register Now for Free"








The site will ask you a few more follow-up questions before you enter the curriculum dashboard: Your role, work location, and who you're working with.

Getting Started


This is the Harmony Curriculum Dashboard. When you first enter the dashboard, there is an opportunity to explore the different things offered by this program. Here are some of the main components we will be using.



Harmony SEL

Select the grade level that you feel is most appropriate for your student(s). If you have students in multiple grades, you may want to select one "grade level" to use for all of your students. Feel free to explore all the lessons by grade level to determine what is most appropriate for your family.

It is recommended that you start with Unit 1: Being My Best Self, but you can choose to start with another Unit if you would like. The most important thing is that you complete each lesson in order, in the Unit you choose.




Time to Teach

After you choose a grade level and unit, it is time to start teaching lessons!

Each lesson will provide the following things:

- An Overview of the lesson and the Learning Goals
- Materials that you will need for the lesson (Stories and print-outs)
- The Parts of the lesson that you will lead
 - Part 1: Set the Stage
 - Part 2: Facilitate the Activity
 - Part 3: Reflect & Review
- Information on how to practice these skills in your daily life



Each Unit has 5 lessons and you will want to create a plan for when you will provide lessons for your student(s). It is suggested that you provide at least 1 lesson per week.
